Imagine Me in the Arts

Programs for Preschoolers

Target ages: 3-5 years old

I'm a singer, a dancer, a writer, an actor, a painter, a drummer...IMAGINE ME!

Our Imagine Me Programs for preschoolers are designed so that children can explore their individual interests, socialize with other children, and express themselves in creative ways in an enriching environment. Stimulating imagination, each course has an emphasis on an art discipline while all are based on discovery learning that will build self esteem, foster creativity, encourage expression and support interests and exposure to the arts through process vs. product. Choose one course, select a few back to back courses or register for them all for a balanced enrichment program. Developed for the preschool child who is potty trained and interested in being exposed to an environment without an accompanying parent.

Mini Michelangelos (focus on visual arts-sculpture)

Expression will be nurtured through hands on mediums. Students will create from materials such as clay, paper mache, and other sculpting materials to create three dimensional art.

Where the Wild Things Are (focus on nature/multi-discipline)

This course is about creating from nature. Students will use their senses to find art in nature, and then create their own instruments, music, paintings and sculptures from items found in nature and from recycled materials.

Preschool Picassos (focus on visual arts-drawing/painting/color basics)

Children will be exposed to the dynamics of black and white and two-dimensional media, while having experiences of seeing, visualizing and expressing themselves on paper. They will be able to experiment with various types of mediums such as finger paints, chalk, pencils, and more.

MOZ-ARTists (focus on performing arts-music/instruments)

These Mozarts will be introduced to and explore the world of playing instruments in a multi sensory and stimulating environment. Students will learn the fundamentals of playing the piano as well as other percussion and melodic instruments.

Oh the Things you can Think (focus on literary arts)

This course is an immersion in literary arts, where children will be exposed to award winning stories of all types. They'll have opportunities to listen, act out and even become the "author" of new and original stories.

Stagekinderkids (focus on performing arts-drama)

Students will be taught to lose their inhibitions and trust their own creative capabilities through fun dramatic activities. This course uses puppets, costumes, masks, props, small set designs, music and movement. A final "show" will be presented to family and friends.

Broad Street Dancers (focus on performing arts-dance)
